Kiernan Milling



Kiernan Milling was founded in 1979. It has built and maintained a reputation for producing quality animal feeds, by using only quality tested raw materials. Our original mill, built in 1979 focused mainly on the production of pig feed. By the mid '90's the company expanded into the poultry sector initially producing turkey feed and then broiler feed. In 2007 the company purchased Stewart's Animal Feeds, a mill based in Boyle, County Roscommon. This acquisition allowed the company to diversify into the ruminant industry where we now have a presence throughout the country through our Merchant network and direct onto farm. To accommodate the increased demand for our product the company invested in a second mill which was opened February 2020.

Aside from the investment in our new Mill we have also invested in our laboratory. Today our laboratory carries out almost 1,000 tests weekly on all our raw materials, finished products, mycotoxins and minerals testing. In September, we hope to be accredited by INAB (Irish National Accreditation Board) for ISO17025 which will allow our laboratory to conduct soil testing. We also hold an accreditation for ISO14001 which is an environmental standard recognised by industry and regulatory bodies. Our Mill is also certified annually by UFAS (Universal Feed Assurance Scheme) which is internationally feed milling standard.

Kiernan Milling is the largest single site multi-species animal feed producer in Ireland. The company's overarching aim remains the same as the day it was founded, which is to produce the highest quality animal feed and to ensure optimal performance and profit for our customers. The company is also committed to reducing our carbon footprint and helping create a more sustainable environment. Since 2014 we have reduced our carbon footprint by 58% and it is our aim to become the first carbon neutral mill in the country by 2027.
